About Carolyn Taylor: Carolyn was an accomplished photographer in the middle of her career when she was diagnosed with ovarian and endometrial cancers in 2006. Inspired by her own ordeal and the experiences of other cancer survivors, Carolyn won a grant from British Airways to photograph women living with cancer around the globe. Her goal through this project was to show how people living with cancer are intrinsically linked.
